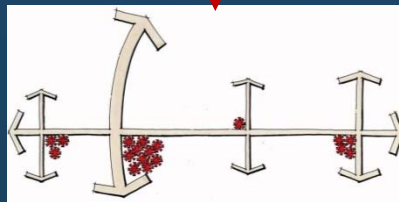
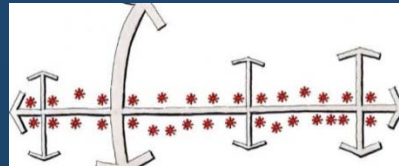

Iterative Feedback Loops

This is not complete streets

Multi-disciplinary teams consist of:

- ❑ Urban Design / Planning
- ❑ Transportation Planning (all modes)
- ❑ Market analysis / planning
- ❑ Environmental infrastructure
- ❑ Community engagement

Complete Streets concepts are part of the Great Streets approach.

End Products

Plan document with costing, phasing, and implementation priorities.

Several elements cued up for STP application

Other elements – clearly defined subsequent work (scope, schedule, budget)

Stewardship strategies developed

Project Sponsor Commitment

Partner with East West Gateway

Provide 20% match funding (up to \$100k) for consultant fees (fees capped at \$500k)

Logistical support of consultant team's community engagement process

Active participation throughout the process

Please note that engaging a consultant to assist with submitting a project application would make that consultant ineligible for working on the project, should it be selected.

Schedule

Call for projects posted – March 23

Symposium / Workshop for potential applicants

April 10, 2:00pm

Project applications due – April 27, 3:00pm

Selection – 3rd week of May

Consultant selection / procurement –

June – August

Work – October – June 30, 2018
