Attached for your approval and use in accordance with paragraph 23 CFR 450.326 are copies of amendments to the 2017-2020 Transportation Improvement Program for the East-West Gateway Council of Governments. The Board of Directors of the MPO approved this TIP amendment on October 26, 2016.

The Metro-East region has committed itself to the integration of transportation and air quality planning. To this end, the MPO has developed procedures for incorporating air quality objectives into the transportation planning process. The TIP amendments, being transmitted by this letter, are in accordance with USDOT metropolitan regulations and USEPA transportation conformity regulations. The MPO has determined that the TIP amendments are in conformance with the State Implementation Program. The changes resulting from these amendments have no effect on the emissions estimates made for the region's conformity determination.

We consider the estimate of costs included in the Transportation Improvement Program to be realistic. We concur with the fiscal consistency analysis included in the TIP. The total cost of the TIP remains consistent with the amount of funds expected to be available to this area during the TIP time period. The Department, on behalf of the Governor of Illinois, concurs with the projects listed in this TIP.

The State of Illinois would also like to amend its FY 2015-2018 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to incorporate this amendment to the East-West Gateway Council of Governments 2017-2020 TIP.

Date: October 12, 2016

The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT), Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT), Metro, Grantwood Village, and the City of Washington, have requested modifications to the FY 2017-2020 TIP, *Connected2045*, and related Air Quality Conformity Determination. In all, they are requesting to add twelve new projects, add six scoping projects, and modify five projects.

Illinois New Projects

IDOT is requesting to add six new projects. Two projects are funded through the Americans with Disability Act (ADA) set-a-side (TIP#6650-17). These projects will construct curb ramps along IL 140 in Alton and Bond St in East St. Louis and Alorton.

Three projects are funded through the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) safety set-aside (TIP# 6686-17). These projects are addressing safety issues by installing traffic signal arrows, centerline rumble strips, and a left turn lane.

The last new project involves a bridge rehabilitation on IL 15, which includes joint repair and deck waterproofing on the bridge over Harding Ditch in St. Clair County.

Missouri New Projects

Grantwood Village, Metro, MODOT, and the City of Washington are requesting to add six new projects to the FY 2017-2020 Transportation Improvement Program.

Local Projects

Grantwood Village has received funding through the Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) to add a turn lane to Grant Road to improve access to the Ulysses S. Grant National Historic Site. FLAP provides resources for transportation facilities that improve access to, are adjacent to, or are located within Federal lands. FLAP projects are selected by a Programming Decision Committee established in each State.

The City of Washington has requested to add one new project for resurfacing on Westlink Drive and West Main Street. The project is funded with Surface Transportation Program – Small Urban (STP-N). STP-N funds are allocated to cities that are not within the urbanized area, but have a population greater than 5,000.

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Metro Projects

Metro is requesting to add two new projects. Metro received a Rides to Wellness (R2W) grant to provide a mobile public health clinic at MetroLink Stations and non-emergency medical transportation for underserved residents. The R2W Initiative is managed by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and is intended to encourage partnerships between transportation and healthcare providers to reduce barriers to healthcare access and improve health outcomes.

Metro has also received funding for the Northside-Southside Pilot Program for Transit Oriented Development (TOD) Planning. This funding through Federal Transit Administration's Pilot Program for TOD Planning will allow Metro to plan for ways that residents and businesses can benefit from a proposed 17-mile, 28-station Metro Link light rail line that will connect downtown St. Louis with the city's northern and southern limits.

MoDOT Projects

MODOT is requesting to add two new projects to the TIP. The first is for pavement improvements on MO DD in Jefferson County and the other is for slide repair throughout the St. Louis District. These projects are funded through bid savings from previously awarded projects.
