Subject: 2022 Agency Budget

Date: November 1, 2021

Attached is the Council's proposed budget for the year beginning January 2022. The Board of Directors reviewed the budget at their October 27, 2021 meeting and has recommended adoption. The budget will be considered at the annual meeting, which will be held using a virtual platform at 1:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 17, 2021. Your attendance at the annual meeting is encouraged. The meeting registration, awards ceremony, and informational sessions are accessible through our website at: https://www.ewgateway.org/amtg-2021/

We are proposing a budget of \$13,051,592. Approximately 26 percent of this budget will pay for public safety planning, equipment, software and training that will be provided to our member local governments and area first responder entities. In addition, another 19 percent will provide consulting services for transportation, economic development, and environmental work. The Council's staff and operating costs is projected to be approximately \$6.7 million. The proposed budget does not call for any increases in local dues or fees.

The budget information provided shows the audited results for 2020 and East-West Gateway's projected resources and expenditures for years 2021 and 2022. We have anticipated that East-West Gateway will receive funding from the States of Missouri and Illinois in support of regional planning efforts over the next year in the amount of \$834,786.
