CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Ted Medler, Chair.

ITEMS

Connected 2045 (Long-Range Transportation Plan) Development – Peter Koeppel presented an overview of the draft Connected 2045 which is the Long-Range Transportation Plan for the St. Louis Region. He stated the draft plan will go out for public comment soon and include both traditional and virtual open houses. The final plan will go to the Board of Directors in June for approval.

FY 2016-2019 TIP Development (action item) – Jason Lange presented an overview of the call for applications for the Surface Transportation Program- Suballocated (STP-S) and Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) Program. The call for applications period began in December and applications were due February 19, 2015. Staff began the evaluation of these projects following the deadline.

There were 85 project applications received for the STP-S program requesting approximately \$115.6 million in federal funds. Based on revenue projections, there is approximately \$50 million in federal funds that would be available for programming. Staff recommended that 48 STP-S projects be recommended for funding totaling approximately \$50.2 million in federal funds as summarized in **Attachment A** of the memo.

There were 32 project applications received for the CMAQ program requesting approximately \$50 million in federal funds. Based on revenue projects, there is approximately \$30 million in federal funding available for programming. Staff recommended that 28 CMAQ projects be recommended for funding totaling

approximately \$31 million in federal funding as summarized in **Attachment B** of the memo.

Jason also discussed feedback that staff received on the projects via the public comment period. There was also discussion about the two funding programs and applications.

The TPC voted to approve the project recommendations for the STP-S program. A motion was made and seconded to approve the project recommendations. Motion carried, all voting aye.

The TPC voted to approve the project recommendations for the CMAQ program. A motion was made and seconded to approve the project recommendations. Motion carried, all voting aye.

Reasonable Progress update – Sonya Pointer gave an update on the monthly Reasonable Progress report. There were eight projects added to the report to reflect the BRM solicitation. There were six preliminary engineering (PE) projects added totaling \$707,160 in federal funds added to this month's report.

Terry Liefer Project Solicitation

East-West Gateway Council of Governments (EWG) announced a call for project $_{\text{Mayor, City of St. Louis}}$ applications for federal funding through the Surface Transportation Program -Steve Stenger Suballocated (STP) and Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) st. Louis County Program on December 16, 2014. A Project Development Workshop took place on that Members same date. This workshop provided additional information on the project application vice President, process and requirements to complete an application. A Project Review Workshop on outnowestern lillinois February 3, 2015 gave project sponsors an opportunity to present their project to a panel representing MoDOT, EWG, Metro, and Trailnet. The panel offered feedback to the project sponsor on their proposed application. The project solicitation process Ted Hoskins concluded on February 19, 2015 when project applications were due.

Surface Transportation Program - Suballocated

Jack Minner Submitted Projects

Local Public Agencies submitted 85 project applications, requesting approximately st. Clair County \$115.6 million in federal funds for consideration through the STP funding program. Mayor, City of East St. Louis **Table A** shows the breakdown of submitted projects by county.

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The project application identifies six priority areas (preservation, safety, congestion, access to opportunity, sustainable development, and goods movement). Projects are assigned to a primary priority area. Most of the projects submitted this year are preservation in nature. This includes projects like bridge replacement/rehabilitations and road reconstruction/ resurfacing. Projects in the safety category include guardrail, intersection improvements (traffic signal or crosswalk improvements), and road realignment. The congestion category includes projects that address congestion, such as new roads, or specific traffic flow improvements, such as a turn lane. Access to opportunity includes projects that improve accessibility. Finally, sustainable development includes enhancement-type projects. **Table B** shows the breakdown of submitted projects by priority area.

Available Funding

Original revenue projections for the FY 2016-2019 TIP estimated that approximately \$50 million would be available for STP programming. The revenue projection was based on uncertainties related to Congress acting on an extension of Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21), which is currently slated to expire on May 31, 2015. It is anticipated that Congress will continue to approve short-term extension of MAP-21 in lieu of a new multi-year transportation funding law.

Since the earlier revenue projections were released we have been tracking STP-S spending and have determined that the earlier estimates were on target. This is in anticipation that funding will continue at levels dedicated to the program through extensions of the current transportation law, MAP-21, and is based on funding stability of the STP program.

Evaluation and Ranking of Projects

Council staff evaluates projects in each of the six priority areas and consistent with the region's long-range transportation plan, *RTP 2040* (preservation, safety, congestion, access to opportunity, sustainable development, goods movement). Projects are assigned to a primary project priority area based on information provided by the project sponsor through the project application. The project's priority area score is determined by how well a project addresses each of the six priority areas. Sponsors can gain additional points based on utilization and type of the facility being improved. Once the final score for a project has been determined, the cost effectiveness of the project is calculated. Cost effectiveness is determined by dividing the annualized total construction cost of the project by the final score.

Finally, locally adopted criteria are applied. This includes at least one project per county. In addition, all projects must be consistent with clean air requirements, must show financial commitment, and must demonstrate a reasonable degree of political and community support.

Typically projects are ranked based on cost effectiveness and funded based on available funding. However, to meet the one project per county criterion, a project may score lower than other projects and still be recommended for funding.

Two project applications were not evaluated. One did not have a letter of support from the facility owner. The other application had two different types of road projects included in the same application. In the past EWG has allowed a sponsor to submit multiple roads in one application so long as the scope of work is similar (i.e. resurfacing only) and the functional classification of roads are the same. The current applications do not meet these criteria. These projects are detailed at the end of **Attachment A**.

Attachment A shows the project cost effectiveness rankings for the STP projects as well as East-West Gateway staff's recommendations for which projects should receive funding. **Table C** shows the breakdown of recommended projects by county.

Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) Program

Submitted Projects

The CMAQ program is for transportation programs or projects that reduce emissions and contribute to the attainment or maintenance of the national ambient air quality standards of ozone, carbon monoxide, and particulate matter. Project sponsors submitted 32 CMAQ applications requesting approximately \$49.6 million in federal funds for consideration. **Table D** shows the breakdown of submitted projects by county.

Available Funding

When projects were originally solicited for the FY 2016-2019 Transportation Improvement Program it was estimated that approximately \$30 million in CMAQ funding was available to program in FY 2016 and 2017. Although MAP-21 extended the CMAQ program through the end of FY 2014, the future of CMAQ is still uncertain due to the lack of a long term funding bill. In the past, Congress has approved short-

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term extensions for transportation funding in lieu of a multi-year law and this is expected to continue.

Since the earlier revenue projections were released we have been tracking CMAQ spending and have determined that \$31 million is available to program. This is in anticipation that funding will continue at levels dedicated to the program through extensions of the current transportation law, MAP-21.

Evaluation of Submitted Projects

The principal criterion for determining project eligibility through the CMAQ program is that an improvement or a service must contribute to a reduction of mobile source emissions for which the area or region is in non-attainment (ozone precursors). Cost per ton of emissions reduced is used in the project selection process as the primary measure to establish priority. This measure is used as a means of comparing various types of projects in a common way, that being the cost per unit of benefit.

The St. Louis region is a non-attainment status for ozone and particulate matter (PM_{2.5}). MAP-21 mandates that at least 25 percent of CMAQ funds be used for projects targeting PM_{2.5} reductions. MAP-21 highlights diesel retrofits or engine replacement with a newer cleaner model as examples of meeting this goal. Replacement of transit vehicles with newer, less polluting models also meets this goal.

Once the projects are ranked relative to cost per ton of emissions reduced, the projects are evaluated consistent with the project/program priorities established in *RTP 2040*. The establishment of project priorities and the selection of projects for funding in the CMAQ program is a direct result of a project's cost effectiveness, the program/ project priority, and the availability of local, federal and other funding.

Two CMAQ applications were not evaluated. One application did not provide sufficient emission data documentation. The other project was requesting additional funding for an ongoing program, however, this program has a balance of unspent funding from previous years. These projects are detailed at the end of **Attachment B**.

Attachment B shows the project rankings of CMAQ projects based on cost per ton of emissions reduced, as well as East-West Gateway staff's recommendations for which projects should receive funding. **Table E** shows the breakdown of recommended projects by county.

Public Feedback

For this application round a new element was included in the form of public feedback on the submitted applications. The intent was to broaden the outreach of East-West Gateway's community engagement by providing a description and cost of the proposed projects by jurisdiction. Feedback was provided through a comment form on the EWG website. The feedback period extended from March 5, 2015 through March 31, 2015. EWG received 163 feedback forms. A detailed summary of feedback will be provided at the TPC meeting.

Project Recommendations - CMAQ and STP

Staff recommends that the projects identified on **Attachment C** be included in the Draft FY 2016-2019 TIP. **Table F** shows all of the project recommendations by county. The Draft FY 2016-2019 TIP will be submitted for public comment at the end of May. Following the public comment period, the FY 2016-2019 will be submitted to the Board of Directors for final approval on July 29, 2015.
