Dear Mr. McKenna:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have reviewed Missouri Department of Transportation's (MoDOT) request to incorporate the East West Gateway Council of Government's (EWGCOG) modification of their FY 2017-2020 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as further described in your letter of February 23, 2017, as an amendment to the FY 2017-2021 Missouri Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The TIP modification to be amended into the STIP includes the addition of two MoDOT and one local public agency sponsored highway projects, and two MoDOT scoping/design projects. The amendment also modifies two currently programmed MoDOT projects, one local public agency project and one Metro sponsored transit project. These projects are exempt with regard to air quality.

The EWGCOG's Board of Directors approved this TIP amendment on January 25, 2017. The Missouri Governor approved the subject TIP amendment on February 17, 2017.

In accordance with 23 CFR 450.218(b), and 450.328(a) and (b), we have determined that this STIP amendment is based on a transportation planning process that substantially meets the requirements of 23 U.S.C 134 and 135, 49 U.S.C. 5303 and 5304 and 23 CFR 450 Subparts A, B, and C. Based on our review, this STIP amendment request is approved.

The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT), Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT), Metro, Jefferson County, and the Cities of Columbia and De Soto, have requested modifications to the FY 2017-2020 TIP, *Connected2045*, and related Air Quality Conformity Determination. In all, they are requesting to add eight new projects, add two scoping projects, and modify four projects.

**Illinois New Projects**

The City of Columbia is requesting to add one new project, at a total cost of \$1,397,300. The project is the second phase of their Main Street Streetscape, which includes items such as lighting, crosswalks, and sidewalk improvements. It is funded through the Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP). ITEP provides funding for projects that expand travel choices and enhance the transportation experience by improving the cultural, historic, aesthetic, and environmental aspects of the transportation infrastructure. Projects are selected after a statewide review and competition among project applications.

IDOT is requesting to add four new projects. One project is funded through IDOT's Americans with Disability Act (ADA) set-aside (TIP#6650-17) and three projects are funded through the safety set-aside (TIP#6686-17).

### **Missouri New Projects**

Jefferson County has requested to add one new project for intersection improvements and roadway realignment on Cedar Hill Road at Local Hillsboro Road. Although the project is located in Cedar Hill Lakes, Jefferson County will act as project sponsor because Cedar Hill Lakes does not have professional staff to oversee this type of project. The total project cost is \$347,187 and is funded with Surface Transportation Program – Small Urban (STP-N) funds, which are allocated to cities that are not within the urbanized area, but have a population greater than 5,000.

MODOT is requesting to add two new projects. Both projects were previously programmed in the TIP for scoping only, and are now funded for construction. MODOT intends to use advance construction<sup>1</sup> for both projects, meaning that the project initially will be funded with 100 percent state funds from MODOT's operations budget until federal funds become available. The anticipated amount of federal funds to be converted is \$1,068,000 (total for two projects) and the anticipated federal funding will

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<sup>1</sup> Advance construction is a mechanism that enables a sponsor to start construction using non-federal funds, with the understanding that it may later convert the project to federal-aid funding and receive federal reimbursement. To be eligible for conversion, the project must qualify for federal funds.

come from the Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG). This project will be funded through MODOT's maintenance budget.
