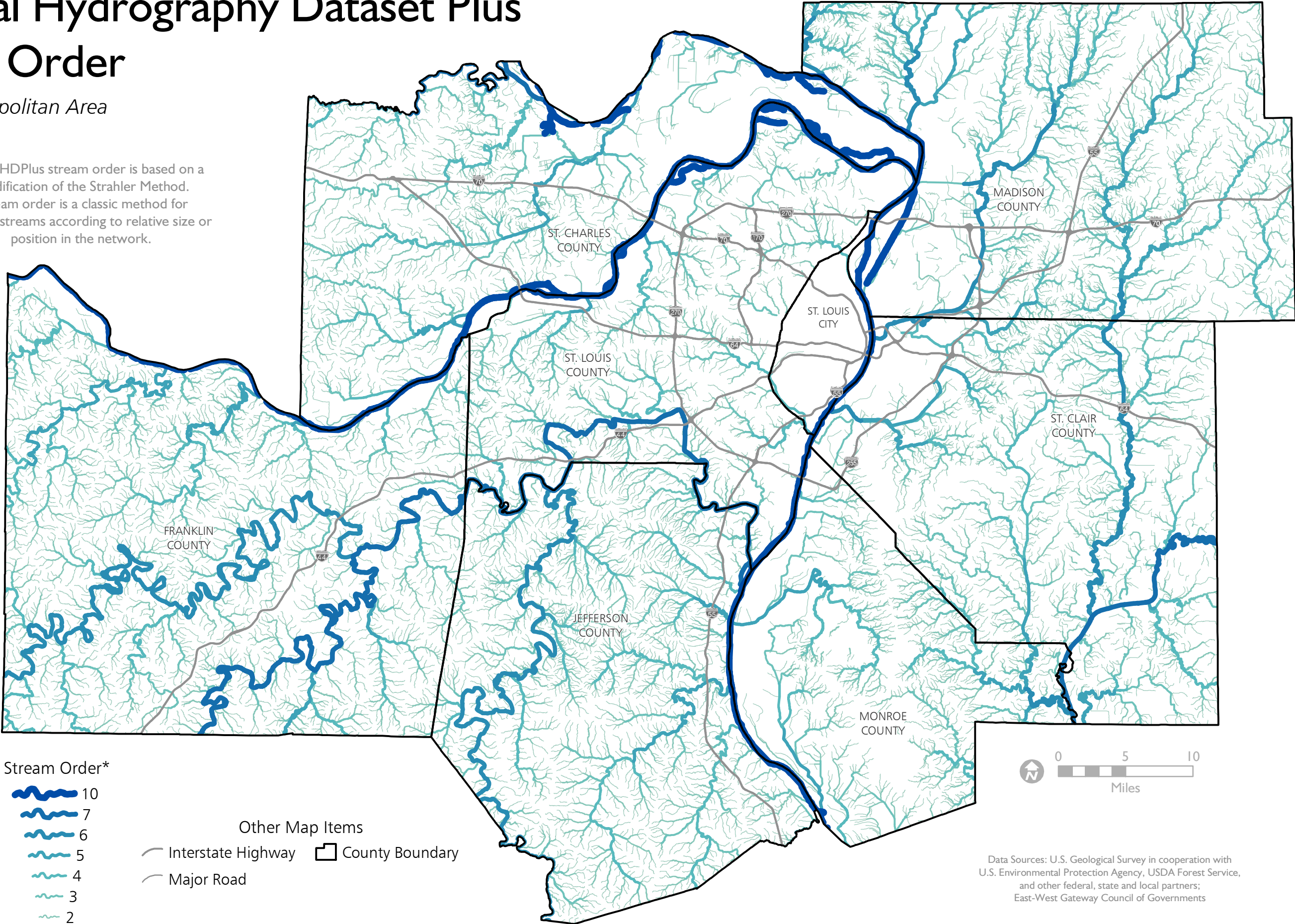




The NHDPlus stream order is based on a modification of the Strahler Method. Stream order is a classic method for ranking streams according to relative size or position in the network.
