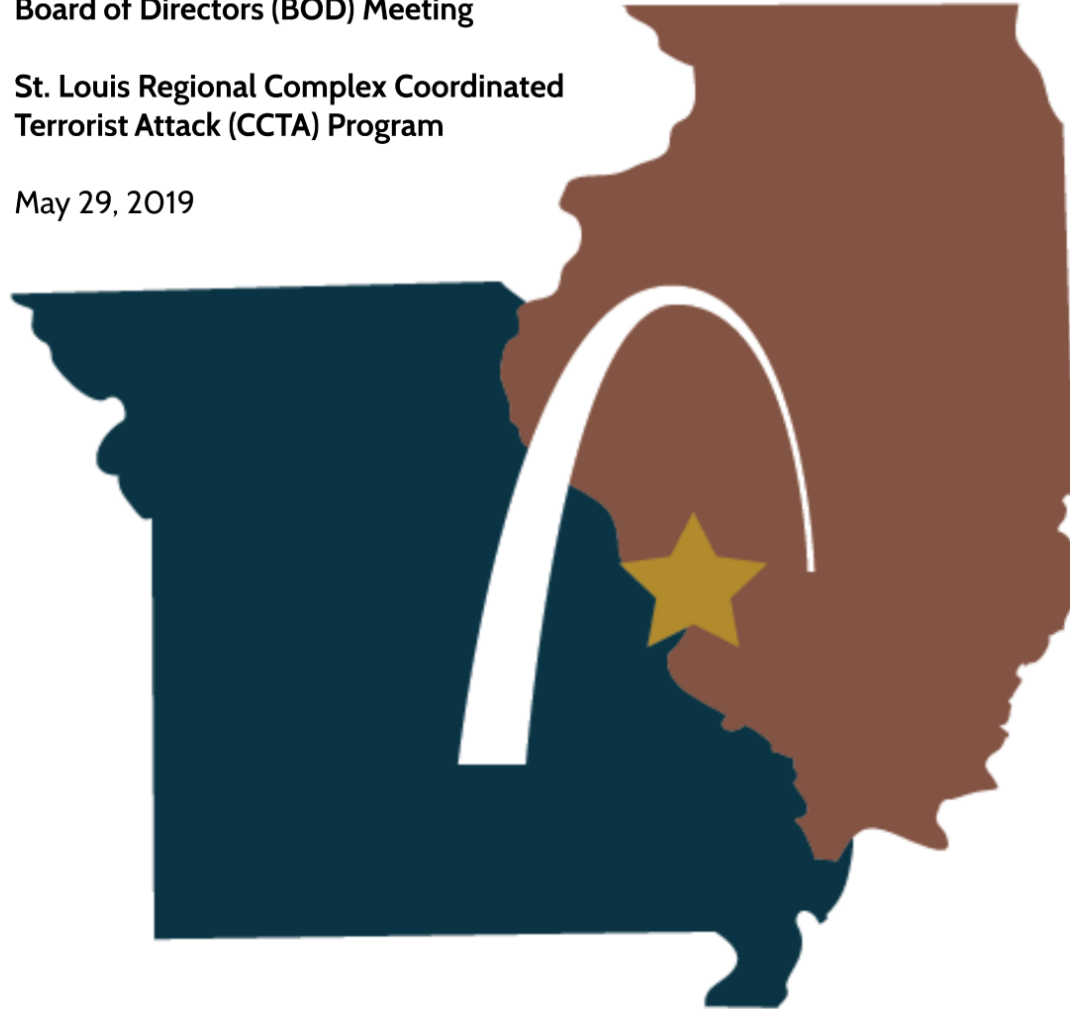

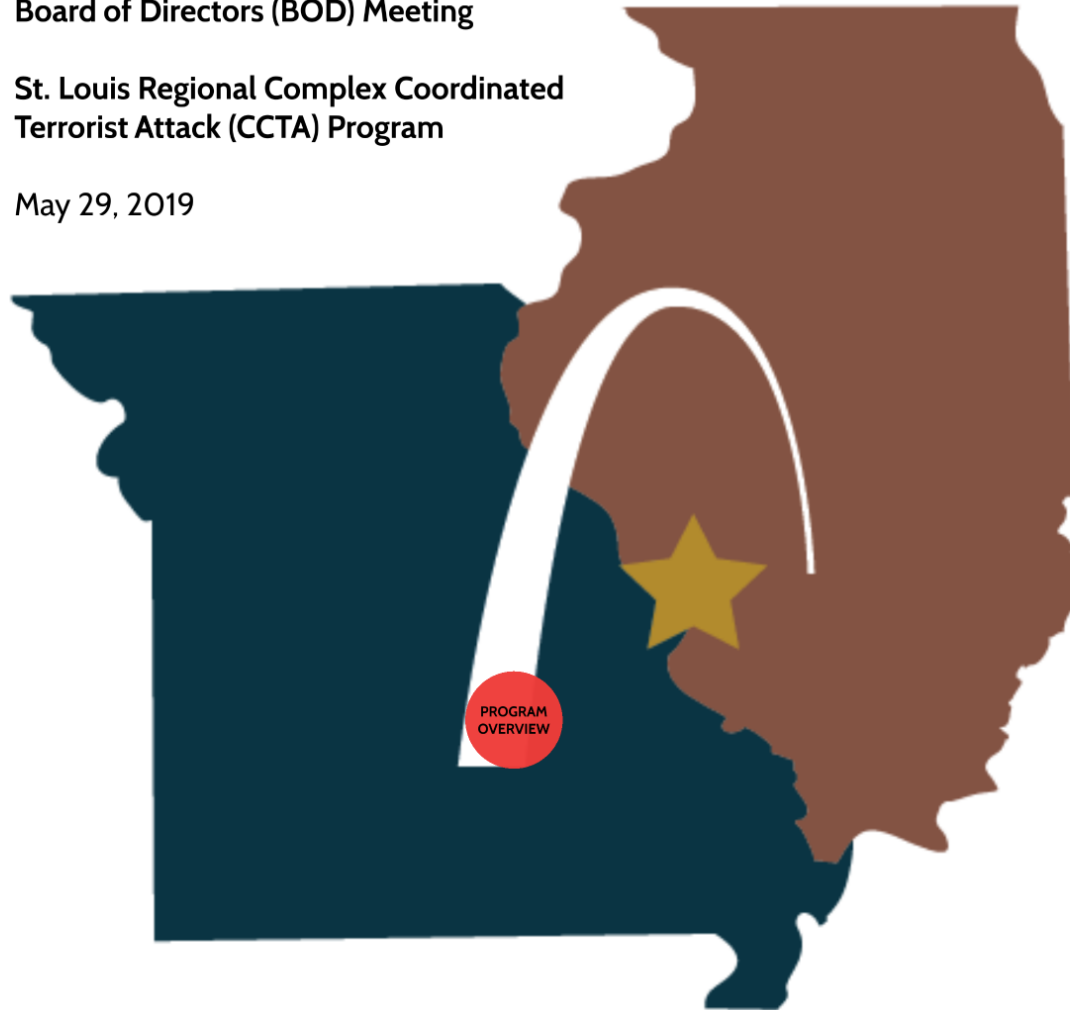

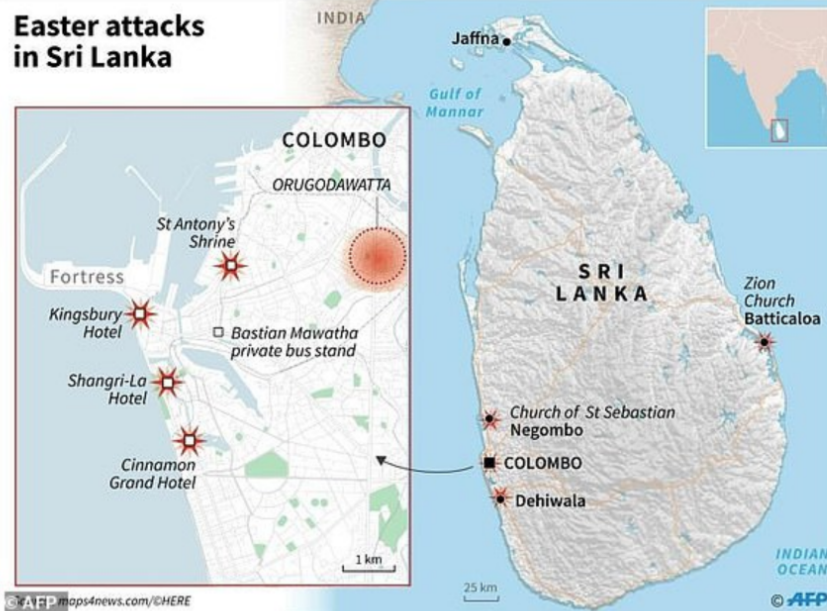
| CCTA Incident | Method | Consequence |
|------------------------|----------------------------------|----------------------------|
| Madrid, 2004 | Train Bombings | 1,800+ Wounded, 190 Killed |
| London, 2005 | Train and Bus Bombings | 784 Wounded, 52 Killed |
| Mumbai, 2008 | Firearms, Bombings, and Arson | 308 Wounded, 164 Killed |
| Paris, 2015 | Firearms and Bombings | 368 Wounded, 130 Killed |
| Brussels, 2016 | Airport and Train Bombings | 330 Wounded, 32 Killed |
| Alexandria/Tanta, 2017 | Church Bombings | 126 Wounded, 45 Killed |
| Barcelona, 2017 | Vehicle Ramming and Knife Attack | 130 Wounded, 16 Killed |

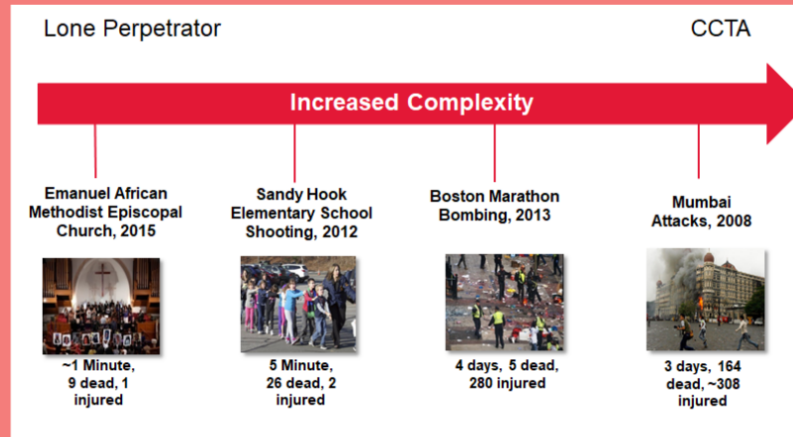

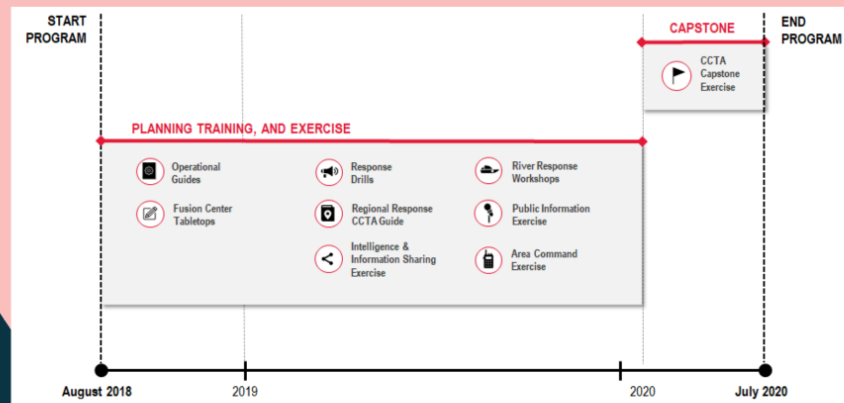


Increased Complexity

- CCTAs are synchronized attacks at multiple locations,
- Implemented by a team or group of teams of assailants,
- Sequentially or in close succession,
- Initiated with little or no warning,
- Employing one or more weapon systems,
- Intended to result in large numbers of casualties.
- Response resources will run out.
- Coordination of responses will be burdensome.

St. Louis Regional CCTA Program

- \$1.4 Million Grant from DHS/FEMA
- 2 states, 8 counties, over 200 municipalities

Common Observable Behaviors

Any one of these activities may seem insignificant on its own, but when observed in combination with other suspicious behaviors may constitute a basis for reporting

- ✓ **Surveillance**
 - Suspicious photographing and/or videotaping; various maps or drawings of locations; note taking
- ✓ **Elicitation**
 - Attempts to gain information on people, locations, security; suspicious or unusual questions
- ✓ **Test of Security**
 - Attempts to gain access to controlled areas; create diversion to observe security response time
- ✓ **Acquiring Supplies**
 - Acquiring weapons, military gear, ammunition, explosives components, uniforms, IDs, vehicles
- ✓ **Suspicious Persons**
 - Individuals in places they don't belong; persons who seem out of place for timing/location
- ✓ **Dry Runs**
 - Mapping routes, photographing security cameras; rehearsal of attack plan
