





- Free data repository for publicly available data in STL region
- Modeled on platforms in Pittsburgh and data.gov
- Launching in July 2019 with pilot City and County data





2. Identify and Organize Existing Community Datasets

Needs Assessments

- Building data analysis tool, data portal, and online report for the 16-County United Way Needs Assessment
- Leveraging platform and cleaned national datasets from The Engagement Network, housed at UM Extension
- Continue to cultivate All Things St. Louis, pulling together list of important community and health indicators
- Recent contract with MO Department of Education to conduct needs assessment for early childhood education
 - looking to replicate UW approach
