Rebuild Illinois Capital Plan

- Signed into law June 2019
- Largest capital plan in Illinois history
- Overall \$45 billion over six years
 - \$25 billion for roads/bridges
 - Primarily funded through:
 - Motor fuel tax increase from \$0.19/gallon to \$0.38/gallon – indexed to inflation
 - Increase in vehicle registration fees
 - Sales taxes on motor fuel purchases
- Governor released IDOT program October 2019



IDOT Program – Major Projects

Title - Description	County	Total Programmed in FY 2020-2023 TIP (millions)	Year of Construction
I-270 over Mississippi River – new bridge	Madison/ St. Louis City	\$214.6	2023
I-255/US 50 – 0.2 mi north of IL 157 to IL 15 – resurfacing, bridge repair, deck overlay	St. Clair	\$46.0	2023
I-64/US 50 – west of Greenmount Rd to 1.1 miles west of IL 158 – additional lanes, bridge repair, resurfacing	St. Clair	\$32.0	2023
I-64 at IL 111 – bridge replacement, interchange reconfiguration	St. Clair	\$28.5	2022

Air Quality Conformity Determination



- Projects must be analyzed to determine conformity with air quality plans and budgets
- All projects must be included in the analysis - - significant projects are “called out” and scrutinized
 - Amendment includes ten such projects
- Projects not included in the analysis can not progress toward implementation
- Analysis complete and all projects conform with state budgets
