Enclosed for your approval and use in accordance with paragraph 23 CFR 450.326 are copies of amendments to the 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program for the East West Gateway Council of Governments (EWGC). At its August 26, 2020 meeting, the EWGCs' Board of Directors amended the Council's FY 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The Board approved the addition of new projects for Illinois sponsors. We consider the estimate of costs included in the Transportation Improvement Program to be realistic. We concur with the fiscal consistency analysis included in the TIP. The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) has requested to amend the FY 2020-2023 TIP, *Connected2045*, and related Air Quality Conformity Determination. In all, they are requesting to modify one existing project. This memo outlines the requested change.

Illinois Modified Project

IDOT has requested to modify one project currently programmed in the TIP. The advancement in fiscal year is intended to address differences between IDOT’s fiscal year 2021 (begins July 1) and federal fiscal year 2021 (begins October 1).
