The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) has reviewed the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) amendment requests submitted via IDOT correspondence as detailed below.

We have determined that the amendment to the corresponding TIPs and STIP for public transportation projects is financially constrained and consistent with the relevant MPO and statewide transportation plans. The project additions are approved for the FY2021-2024 STIP.

Madison County Transit District and the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) have requested to amend the FY 2021-2024 TIP, *Connected2045*, and the related Air Quality Conformity Determination. In all, they are requesting to add one new project, modify two projects, and add one scoping project. This memo outlines the requested changes.

Illinois New Project

Madison County Transit District has requested to add one new project to the FY 2021-2024 TIP. This project is summarized below.
