Subject: Modifications to the FY 2022-2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), *Connected2045*, and the Related Air Quality Conformity Determination – Requested by Illinois & Missouri Sponsors

Date: April 12, 2022

The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) and Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) have requested to amend the FY 2022-2025 TIP, *Connected2045*, and the related Air Quality Conformity Determination. In all, they are requesting to add two new projects and modify five projects. This memo outlines the requested changes.

Illinois New Projects

IDOT has requested to add two new projects on behalf of Monroe County to the FY 2022-2025 TIP. Funding for these projects are coming from Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds. HSIP projects are selected by IDOT following a statewide solicitation for projects.

The new projects are summarized on the following table:

Missouri Modified Projects

State FY 2023 overlaps federal FY 2022 between July and October. The engineers estimate for TIP# 4414H-12 is increasing to account for rising costs in steel.
