The meeting of the STARRS Board of Directors was called to order at 9:00 a.m. via telephone conference call, with attendance as follows (absent stricken through):

CALL TO ORDER

Warren Robinson called the meeting to order at 0900. Staci Alvarez took attendance, confirming a quorum.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Warren requested approval of the September 2021 minutes. A motion was made by Joann Leykam and was seconded by Jason Campbell. The motion carried and was approved.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

DIRECTORS REPORT

Gregg Favre shared that the NOFO for the UASI 2022 grant is expected to drop next month and that we expect a similar process to the last few last year, including National Priorities and tracking Investments back to the region's THIRA report. STARRS staff is available to meet committees to assist with creation of IJs. STARRS recently filled the RCPG grant position with Kristen Capps-Jones, who has a 15 years background in public safety and a Masters from MU. EWG has requested for a grant extension on this RCPG grant due to the timeline constraints and the covid disruptions. The intention is that the

project will run somewhat like the CCTA grant project that the region is familiar with. Kristen continues to reach out to other RCPG recipients to coordinate focus and activities. Committees should be updating their membership lists for the February annual STARRS Board meeting. The 2021 HSAC report has been completed and submitted to the state. STARRS was highlighted in the national HSIN report for our wrap-up of the CCTA project, receiving high praise for meeting DHS deliverables. The state of Missouri earthquake summit will be in St. Louis on March 3rd, 2022. Information will be sent out soon on this via the Training & Exercise committee. STARRS received feedback from 37 participants in the recent T&E survey process, and Gregg thanked them for their participation. Gregg also thanked the region's responders for their response to the recent Tornado events in the metro east and west. The SMOC's response that night went well and recently performed an AAR of the event. The SMOC also recently assisted a local hospital with a supply shortage. The Illinois State Police STIC thanked the Fusion Center for their participation in the apprehension of a suspect in the murder of an Illinois police officer.

2021 THIRA/SPR CLOSEOUT

Samantha (STARRS) shared thanks with the group for participation in the THIRA/SPR closeout, sharing that they did a SWAT analysis of the events and identified that a whole community exercise was identified as a priority. The IPPW planning process also benefitted from the THIRA/SPR process. The new 2022 THIRA/SPR process will incorporate more breakout groups to incorporate more stakeholder input, increasing the involvement by subcommittees and spreading the process out over the year to help with the time commitment.

TRAINING & EXERCISE SURVEY & NEXT STEPS

Samantha (STARRS) shared an update on the T&E surveys from August 2021 and beyond. Comments and feedback were incorporated into the improvement plan. Needs identified in the process included a STARRS Welcome Packet to explain funding processes and to explain past funding successes. Additional regional training & exercise desires for the region were also identified. Discussions is also occurring on updating the process from 3 year to 5 year plan. The creation of a Training & Exercise newsletter to share information about upcoming events is also being looked at. Sam is anticipating another T&E survey in August/September of this year.

SUB-COMMITTEE REPORTS

John Nowak shared that the EMS sub-committee is working on electing officers and updating membership at their meeting next Wednesday. Ryan Nicholls shared that the Healthcare Coalition is working on their strategic vision and plans at their next meeting. Jason Campbell shared that the Healthcare Preparedness subcommittee met yesterday, and that they approved their 2021 Annual report. The report shows they achieved 94% of their objectives. They also approved their 2022 goals workplan. Focus areas for this year include the new subcommittee website, strengthening management of the budget process, advancing engagement and recruitment, and laying the foundation for a multiyear initiative to develop a healthcare EM professional academy. Jason shared thanks with the group for approval of the new website. Roger Smith shared that one of the Mass Fatality sub-committee co-chairs, Kathleen Hargrave, has stepped down and was replaced by Dr. Lindsay Trammell. Dr. Trammell is a forensic anthropologist for the St. Louis County Medical Examiner's office. Justen Hauser shared that the Public Health sub-committee

continues to focus on covid response activities including covid testing and covid vaccinations. Derek Rieger shared a Training & Exercise sub-committee update, thanking Samantha Peterson (STARRS) for all the hard work with their committee. Brian Gettemieir shared that the USAR teams from St. Louis City and Illinois participated in a November trench collapse incident with a successful rescue and that 4/5ths of the USAR team assets were active in the December tornado incidents in Defiance. MO and in the Illinois incidents.

ACTION ITEMS

REGIONAL SECURITY EXPENDITURE

Gregg shared information on the month's purchase of a Geopolitical Intelligence module for the existing Recorded Future system at the Fusion center for \$40,000. Gregg also shared information on the renewal of the Cybersecurity Coordinator position from the City of St. Louis for a cost not to exceed \$160,000. Gregg also shared information on the funding of the new SAR ILO position at the Fusion Center from Jefferson County for \$110,000. Chris Hunt asked for clarification on the Cybersecurity Coordinator position funding approval process, and Leah Watkins shared background information on the process. Joann Leykam motioned to approve the expenditures and Tony Falconio seconded. The motion carried and the expenditures were approved without opposition.

OTHER BUSINESS

No other business was presented.

NEXT MEETING & ADJOURNMENT

The next meeting of the STARRS Board is scheduled for February 10, 2022. Warren requested a motion to adjourn, which was provided by Joann Leykam and seconded by Tony Falconio. The motion carried and the meeting was adjourned at 9:31AM.
