November 7, 2022 St. Louis region (MO-IL) reclassified from Marginal to Moderate for 2015 eight-hour ozone standard. Based on 2018 – 2020 monitor data, area did not attain this standard by August 3, 2021 attainment deadline for Marginal nonattainment areas
