Local Program Schedule

Applications go online November 3, 2023.

EWG will host three project development workshops to provide information on the funding programs, including program eligibility and requirements, project applications, scoring criteria, and available funding.

- Illinois: Thursday, November 16, 2023 at the IDOT District 8 Office in Collinsville
- All workshops are 9:30-11:30 a.m.

Application deadline is 4:00 PM, February 8, 2024.

Staff will present local projects recommended for funding in May 2024.

Program Definitions

Surface Transportation Block Grant Program – Suballocated (STP-S)

- Eligible project types include: road resurfacing, reconstruction, bicycle and pedestrian facilities, bridge rehabilitation and replacement, new roads, intersection improvements, transit capital, traffic flow improvements.

Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ)

- Eligible project types include: traffic flow improvements, demand management, shared ride services, bicycle/pedestrian facilities, transit improvements, and diesel engine retrofits.

Carbon Reduction Program (CRP)

- Eligible project types include: traffic management technologies, traffic flow improvements, bicycle/pedestrian facilities, transit vehicles/facilities, alternate fuel/charging infrastructure, diesel engine retrofits, congestion pricing and mode shift efforts, and developing carbon reduction strategies.

Off-System Bridge Program (BRO/BFP)

- Provides funding for bridge rehabilitation and replacement projects on roads classified as local or minor collector.
BRO/BFP is available to Missouri sponsors only.
